<b>Science</b>	<b>100 Level:</b> Biology (2 sections, 1 unit), Earth & Space Sci (1 section/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: JC BIO courses</i> <b>200 Level:</b> Chemistry (2 sections/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: JC CEM 131 or JC CEM 132 or JC CEM 141 or JC CEM 142 or JC CEM 241 or JC CEM 242</i> <b>300 Level:</b> Physics (1 section/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: JC PHY 131 or JC PHY 145 or JC PHY 150 or JC PHY 231 or JC PHY 232 or JC PHY 251 or JC PHY 252</i> <b>400 Level:</b> College level science course (if needed for degree)	4 Units

<b>Social Studies</b>	<b>100 Level:</b> U.S. History (3 sections/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: JC HIS 125 or JC HIS 231 or JC HIS 232 or JC HIS 211</i> <b>200 Level:</b> World History (3 sections/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: JC HIS 120 or JC HIS 131 or JC HIS 132 or JC HIS 235</i> <b>300 Level:</b> Civics or JC PLS 141 (1 unit) <b>400 Level:</b> Economics or JC ECN 231 or JC ECN 232 (1 unit)	4 Units
<b>Visual/ Performing Arts</b>	<b>Choose Two of the Following (2 units):</b> Band Course (1 section/1 unit) Choir Course (1 section/1 unit) Music Appreciation or Music History (1 section/1 unit) Art Course (1 section/1 unit) <i>College level substitutions: Any JC ART course or JC HUM 131 or JC MUS course</i>	2 Units
<b>PE/ Health</b>	-Physical Education (1 unit) -Health Education (1 unit) <i>College level courses cannot substitute these requirements.</i>	2 Units
<b>World Language</b>	Earned through a foreign language study, college dual enrolled class, and/or an appropriate cultural K-12 experience <b>OR</b> JPEC GLO or ANT courses <i>Any foreign language courses taken at a college/university.</i>	2 Units
<b>Online Learning</b>	Earned through an approved JPEC course or a dual enrolled college course	0.5 Unit
<b>Job Shadowing/ Community Service</b>	<b>Choose One of the Following:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. 100 hours of verified community service (1 unit)</li> <li>2. A minimum of 40 hours of verified career exploration, internship, job shadowing, or clinical experience. (1 unit)</li> <li>3. A combination of the two that equals 70 or more hours. (1 unit)</li> </ol>	1 Unit
<b>EMC Requirements</b>	Every student must pass a minimum of 15 college credits (1 unit)	1 Unit
<b>Academic Mentorship</b>	Focus Group (*3 units per year of attendance) (15 units for 5 years)	Up to *15 units
<b>Requirements Total</b>		<b>*39.5 Units</b>
